The Academy reserves the right to modify these guidelines as needed. Parents/students will be given adequate notification accordingly.

Boys/Young Men

- 1. Uniform pants.
- 2. School shirt with school name embroidered (long or short sleeve).
- 3. School sweater/cardigan with school name embroidered.
- 4. School blazer with school name embroidered.
- 5. Kufi to be worn for Jummah, (knit/crochet style) solid white, beige or black. (optional)
- 6. Black dress shoes.
- 7. School-issued gym uniforms.
- 8. No jewelry. Wrist watches are permitted.
- 9. Short or medium length hair of equal length. (no fades, high tops, etc.)
- 10. Short trimmed nails. No henna.

Girls/Young Women

- 1. School-issued dress, skirt, or abaya.
- 2. School-issued hijab
- 3. School-issued pants (Mini-Section Grade 5 only)
- 4. School-issued sweater/cardigan with school name embroidered.
- 5. School blazer with school name embroidered.
- 6. Black shoes (not sneakers); no high heels.
- 7. School-issued gym uniform.
- 8. No make-up is permitted (including but not limited to kohl for eyes, lip gloss, perfume).
- 9. Henna is permitted on nails and hands.
- 10. No fake nails. No fingernail polish at any time (even when older girls are unable to pray). Henna is permitted.
- 11. No hair extensions of any type.
- 12. Short trimmed nails.
- 13. No jewelry. Wrist watches are permitted. Earrings or necklaces may be worn as long as they are not visible through the hijab.

Please clearly label all items of clothing with your child's name.
